The Problem

Lacking a local cryptocurrency exchange for people to purchase and trade easily in Sri Lanka.

Price is an important concern for people in developing countries when considering making investments (both digital and physical assets).

Affordability is extremely low for top five cryptocurrencies, and makes them more risky as safe assets in developing countries.

Volatility leaves investors and speculators somewhat reluctant to engage.


Token models mostly <u>expect</u> utility of platforms will indirectly drive value (external demand) instead of <u>internally</u> tying the platform to its token value through real economic activity.





The Solution

An exchange which <u>buys back its token</u> as and when fees are collected from trading transactions.





Business & Token Valuation Model

Since our <u>initial</u> market will be Sri Lanka; below stats focus on the country with values represented in USD using **conservative figures**.

For the purpose of demonstration, **only the LKR markets** will be considered; we will take a 2.5% commission on each transaction in these markets.

Initial buy back percentage is 50% of fees collected; and are used to create a limit buy order (25%) and a market order (25%).






